Introduction to the Psalms

The Use of Psalms in Israel

The psalms served the crucial function of __CONNECTING__ the worshiper to God. They were commonly used as __WORSHIP AIDS__ by Israelites when they brought sacrifices to the temple in Jerusalem. They gave the Israelites words to express their __EMOTIONS__.

Types of Psalms

Laments – These help worshipers express __STRUGGLES__, __SUFFERING__, and __DISAPPOINTMENT__ to the Lord. (eg., 31, 88, 120)

Thanksgiving – These help worshipers express __JOY__ and __GRATITUDE__. (eg., 67, 116, 138)

Praise – These center on the praise of God for __WHO HE IS__ (eg., 19, 103, 114)

Salvation-History – These ___REVIEW__ the history of God's saving works among the people of Israel, especially his deliverance of them from bondage. (eg,. 78, 105, 135)

Wisdom – These praise the merits of __WISDOM__ and the wise life. (eg., 36, 49, 127)

Songs of Trust – These proclaim that God can be __TRUSTED__. (eg., 11, 23, 121)

Celebration and Affirmation - Covenant renewal psalms, which are used to lead God's people to a ___RENEWAL__ of the covenant he first gave them on Mt. Sinai (eg., 50, 81). Davidic covenant psalms, which praise the importance of God's choice of the lineage of __DAVID__ (eg., 89, 132). Royal psalms, which deal with human and divine __KINGSHIP__ (eg., 2, 18). Songs of Zion focus on the place where the __TEMPLE__ was built, which was a visible expression of God's presence and the place from which the king exercised his authority (eg., 48, 87).

Imprecatory – These express __ANGER__ and __HATRED__ toward enemies (eg., 58, 137)

Psalms for the NT believer

"...but be filled with the Spirit, addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord with your heart..." (Ephesians 5:18-19)

"Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God." (Colossians 3:16)

Their importance to us:

- 1. The psalms serve as a __GUIDE__ to worship.
- 2. The psalms demonstrate how we can __RELATE HONESTLY__ to God.
- 3. The psalms demonstrate the importance of __REFLECTION__ and __MEDITATION__ on the things that God has done for us.
